Notes

- Only the vowel forms that appear at the beginning of a syllable are listed; the forms used for vowels following a consonant exclude ଙା. No distinction between the two is made in romanization.

- The vowel *a* is implicit after all consonants and consonant clusters and is supplied in romanization, with the following exceptions:

(a) when another vowel is indicated by its appropriate sign; and

(b) when the absence of any vowel is indicated by the subscript sign (_) called *sa-i*.

RULES OF APPLICATION

1. -' (*mukphreni*) is used to indicate a slight breathing after a vowel. It is romanized *h*.

2. -' (*kemphreni*) is used to make a vowel slightly longer than usual. It is romanized '.

3. When Z, ୤, ୩, ୪, ୧, ୨, and ୯ are used in the final position (i.e., preceded by a vowel but not followed by one), they assume different shapes and are used as superscripts above the preceding syllables.

4. When ୤ is added to another consonant or consonants in a cluster (i.e., without any intervening vowel), it assumes the shape ୤ and is added to the preceding consonant or consonants.

5. When ୧ is added to another consonant or consonant in a cluster (i.e., without any intervening vowel), it assumes the shape ୧ and is added to the preceding consonant or consonants.

6. When ୨ is added to another consonant or consonants in a cluster (i.e., without any intervening vowel) it assumes the shape ୨ and is added to the preceding consonant or consonants.
