The American's with Disabilities Act, Section 508, establishes requirements for electronic and information technology developed, maintained, procured and or used by the federal government. It requires federal systems to be available to all people with disabilities, including employees and members of the public. Join Bruce Bailey from the U.S. Access Board, as he provides an introduction to Section 508, covers the key requirements of Section 508, and updates participants on the refresh of Section 508. This is the first in a series of Section 508 programs presented by CENDI/FLICC/FADGI.

Bruce Bailey is an IT Specialist at the U.S. Access Board. He has lead responsibility for the agency Web site and technical assistance on Section 508 Web compliance. Bruce has been working for 20 years in the field of assistive technology, and in the last 10 of those years in the federal government. Bailey also is an invited expert with the W3C WAI Web Content Accessibility Guidelines Working Group and an ex officio member of the National Instructional Materials Accessibility Standards (NIMAS) Board.
