is home to the Albert H. Small Center for National Capital Area Studies and its collection of Washington, D.C., history, as well as a non-circulating library. The center features the Washingtoniana Collection, which traces the founding and evolution of Washington, D.C., as a city and a national capital. It includes nearly 2,000 prints, maps, manuscripts, books, newspapers, broadsides, and photographs.

Curator Kasey Sease, Ph.D., will lead a visit to the Albert H. Small Center and offer a tour of the two exhibitions currently on display. *Capital Accommodations* examines the layered histories of D.C.'s hotels, boarding houses, and more. *From A to DC: Transportation in Washington* explores the history of D.C.'s travel systems, including land, air, and sea.
