
Metro/Directions:

The U.S. Army Center of Military History (CMH) Library and Archives supports Army historians and conducts research on numerous queries from the Army, the Department of Defense, and other federal agencies. The collection features nearly 40,000 volumes and a repository containing a treasure trove of primary resources on Army operations.

The tour will include one of the hidden gems at Fort McNair — the restored Lincoln Assassination Conspirators Trial Courtroom. In present-day Grant Hall, eight members of John Wilkes Booth's conspiracy faced trial in the summer of 1865. The presentation will feature highlights such as the U.S. government's capture of the conspirators, the outcome of the trial, the fates of those convicted, and the enduring legacy of this historical event.
