## → Maximize Your Books and Media Budget

- Using FEDLINK's Transfer Pay option, federal libraries can place orders with a variety of FEDLINK books and media vendors.
- Check reports from vendors for back-orders and cancellations. If a vendor cancels or places any book on back order for more than 30 days, funds obligated for these titles can be released for new orders. Alert FEDLINK so we can assist you!
- Please allow 30 days for FEDLINK to complete the deobligation process, and be sure to follow FEDLINK's [fiscal-year deadlines](#).
